Dr. Cynthia Easton, DVM, who will speak on the use of Eastern and Western medicine in veterinary practice today and how it relates to canine nutrition. Dr. Easton will also address other subjects pertinent to flat faced breeds.

A brief biography of the speakers:

Dr. Easton is a graduate of the Veterinary School of Medicine at the University of California, Davis and has practiced veterinary medicine for over 15 years. After a medicine and surgery internship at the University of Pennsylvania Veterinary School, Dr. Easton worked for a clinic in San Francisco CA where she began pursuing an interest in holistic medicine. Dr. Easton has taken courses in Homeopathy, Western and Chinese Herbology, and is certified by the International Veterinary Acupuncture Society. Dr. Easton now practices out of the Mid Peninsula Animal Hospital; AAHA, in Menlo Park and the Bishop Ranch Veterinary Center in San Ramon.

Ms. Serror-Secher is a long time French Bulldog breeder, competitor and enthusiast. An outspoken advocate of the breed, she has been involved with purebred dogs most of her life. She is well known as a respected breeder of French Bulldogs and her breeding program has contributed much to the breed in California as well as nationally. Ms. Serror-Secher is always willing to share her knowledge and experience with fellow French Bulldog enthusiasts and she continues to be influential in the breed today.
